| BLUE | fingering numbers $=$ play these notes on the G string |
| :--- | :--- |
| GOLD | fingering numbers $=$ play these notes on the D string |
| GREEN | fingering numbers $=$ play these notes on the A string |
| PURPLE fingering numbers $=$ play these notes on the E string |  |
