Bonnet « C'est pas le Pérou ! »

Size 6/8 years old, 53/54cm of hat size

Material :

1 ball of Reggae Schoppel Wolle

Circular needles 5mm, 1 stitch marker,

2 stitch holder

A sew needle, wood pearls or anything you want to finish your hat.

Abbreviations and points :

k : knit

p:purl

P2tog : purl 2 together

K2tog : knit 2 together

m1 : make 1 : means create 2 st in 1.

\*...\* repeat from \*to\* , as many times as you need.

st: stitch

Stocking stitch (straight needles ):

Knit the right side row, purl the wrong side row.

Garter stitch (circular needles) :

Round 1 : knit

Round 2 : purl

Repeat these 2 rounds.

Seed stitch (circular needles) :

Round 1: \*k1, p1\*, k1

Round 2: \*p1, k1\*, p1.

Repeat these 2 rounds.

Gauge : (Stocking stitch 10cm/10cm) :18 st /24 rows.



Work :

## <u>Ears :</u>

Cast on 4 st, knit 14 cm of stocking st.

Then :

Row 1 (right side) :m1, k2, m1 ( 6st)

Row 2 and all wrong side rows: purl.

Row 3: m1, k4, m1 (8st)

Row 5: m1, k6, m1 (10st)

Row 7: m1, k8, m1 (12st)

Row 9: m1, k10, m1 (14st)

Row 11: m1, k12, m1 (16st)

Row 13: m1, k14, m1 (18st)

Row 15: knit

Row16: purl

Cut the tread at 20cm, and put it on a stitch holder. Knit the second one the same way

## Body of the hat :

Cast on 24 st, then knit the first ear, cast on 10st, knit the second ear, you will have 70st.

Put the stitch marker, close the ring , knit one round and then do 4 rounds of garter stitch.

Note, In these 4 rounds of garter st., m1 and you will have 71st.

Then, knit in seed st. up to 7cm, so do 4 rows of garter st;, including 1K2tog to have finally 70st.

<u>The ribs :</u>

I give you two possibility for the ribs: one with more purl st. and the other with more knit st, as you prefer!.

With more purl st. :

Do ribs up to 13cm (body of the hat), like this :

Round : \*p5, k2\*

Repeat this round as many times as necessary

Decrease :

Round 1 : \*P2tog, p3, k2\*

Round 2 and even rounds knit stitches as they appear.

Round 3 : \*P2tog, p2, k2\*

Round 5 : \*P2tog, p1, k2\*

Round 7 : \*P2tog, k2\*

Round 9 : \*p1, K2tog\*

Make the round 10 then to cut the thread, fix the top of the hat, bring in the threads, make the finishes with pearls at your convenience at the foot of ears, you can also put bracelet charms, make pompoms ...

With more knit st. :

Do ribs up to 13cm (body of the hat), like this :

Round : \*k5, p2\*

Repeat this round as many times as necessary

Decrease :

Round 1 : \*K2tog, k3, p2\*

Round 2 and even rounds knit stitches as they appear.

Round 3: \*K2tog, k2, p2\*

Round 5: \*K2tog, k1,p2\*

Round 7: \*K2tog, p2\*

Round 9 : \*k1, P2tog\*

Make the round 10 then to cut the thread, fix the top of the hat, bring in the threads, make the finishes with pearls at your convenience at the foot of ears, you can also put bracelet charms, make pompoms ...
