

## Slouch Shadow

This falling hat is very easy to knit, the employee yarn gives it its originality.

## <u>Material:</u>

1 ball of <u>Shadow Schulana</u>. Circular needles 5mm, with a cable of 60cm.

1 stitch marker, tapestry or sew needle 1 measuring tape, 1 pair of scissors.

Points and abbreviations:

st: stitch

k:knit

K2tog: knit 2 st together

m1: make 1 ( see there)

p: purl

\*...\* : knitting pattern indicated between \* and \* as many times as necessary to finish the round. Ribs 1/1 : always knit this round \*k1, p1\* to the desired height.

<u>Work:</u>

Cast on 80 st flexibly or long cast tail (<u>see there</u>). Form a circle, put the stitch marker to see the start of the round and start knitting in rib 1/1 to 5cm high.

Then increase as follows : Knit 2 rounds, and then :

1 round: \*k8, m1\*, Then knit 3 rounds (90st)

1 round: \*9md, m1\*, Then knit 3 rounds. (100st)

1 round: \*10md, m1\*, Then knit 3 rounds. (110st)

Then knit every round up to a total height of the cap 16 to 17.5cm (depending on the desired size) and start to decreases.

1 round: \*k8, K2tog\*, then knit 1 round.

1 round: \*k7, K2tog\*, then knit 1 round.

1 round: \*k6, K2tog\*, then knit 1 round.

1 round: \*k5, K2tog\*, then knit 1 round.

1 round: \*k4, K2tog\*, then knit 1 round.

1 round: \*k3, K2tog\*, then knit 1 round.

1 round: \*k2, K2tog\*, then knit 1 round.

1 round : \*k1, K2tog\*, then cut the wire at 30 cm, put it on the yarn needle. Pull thread through remaining sts, tighten the wire board in sts, tighten again. Fasten thread in the cap, and cut it. Retract the beginning of cap wire into the st and cut.
