# ∴ The DANE ∴ The Hats for dadys and sonnys (and possibly for mummys)

3 sizes: babys (9/24 month) - child (4/10 years,) - adulte.

#### Material:

- Circular Needle us 6 4,0 mm
- 1 ball of blue yarn (here Phildar charly)
- 1 ball of black yarn

#### Gauge:

20 stitches = 4 inches - 10 cm 34 rows = 4 inches - 10 cm

#### **Abbreviations:**

k2tog: knit two stitches together



#### Le Dane - Adulte

With **blue yarn**, cast-on 96 stitches. place marker, and join for knitting in the round.

Round 1: \*k1,p2\* to end of round.

Work in 1X2 ribbing by repeating round 1 until hat measures 5,5 cm (about 21/6 inches).

Knit 4 rounds in Garter stitch (creating 2 ridges)

Switch to stockinette stitch (knit all rounds) and continue until hat measures 4,92 inches (=12,5cm) from cast on edge.

Now, Switch to stockinette stitch with **black yarn** until hat measures 5.51 inches (=14cm).

Decrease top of hat as follows:

Round 1: \*k2tog, k8\*, repeat until 4 stitches remains, Knit1.

Round 2-4: knit.

Round 5: \*k2tog, k7\* repeat until 3 stitches remains, Knit1.

Round 6 and all even rounds: knit.

Round 7: \*k2tog, k6\* repeat until 2 stitches remains, Knit1.

Round 9: \*k2tog, k5\* repeat until 1 stitches remains, Knit1.

Round 11: \*k2tog, k4\* repeat until 2 stitches remains, Knit1.

Round 13: \*k2tog, k3\* repeat until 3 stitches remains, Knit1.

Round 15: \*k2tog, k2\* repeat until 2 stitches remains, Knit1.

Round 17: k2tog all stitches.

Break yarn and draw tail through the remaining stitches.

### Le Dane - Child

With **blue yarn**, cast-on 89 stitches. place marker, and join for knitting in the round.

Round 1: \*k1,p2\* to end of round.

Work in 1X2 ribbing by repeating round 1 until hat measures 4,5 cm - about 1,77 inches.

Knit 4 rounds in Garter stitch (creating 2 ridges)

Switch to stockinette stitch (knit all rounds) and continue until hat measures 10 cm - about 3,94 inches - from cast on edge.

Now, switch to stockinette stitch with **black yarn** until hat measures 13 cm – about 5.11 inches from cast on edge.

Decrease top of hat as follows:

Round 1: \*k2tog, k7\*, repeat until 1 stich remains, kinit 1.

Round 2-4: knit.

Round 5: \*k2tog, k6\* repeat until 1 stich remains, kinit 1.

Round 6 and all even rounds: knit.

Round 7: \*k2tog, k5\* repeat until 1 stich remains, kinit 1.

Round 9: \*k2tog, k4\* repeat until 1 stich remains, kinit 1.

Round 11: \*k2tog, k3\* repeat until 1 stich remains, kinit 1.

Round 13: \*k2tog, k2\* repeat until 1 stich remains, kinit 1.

Round 15: k2tog all stitches.

Break yarn and draw tail through the remaining stitches.

# Le dane : baby

With **blue yarn**, Cast-on 81 stitches. place marker, and join for knitting in the round.

Round 1: \*k1,p2\* to end of the round.

Work in 1X2 ribbing by repeating round 1 until hat measures 4 cm - about 1,57 inches.

Knit 4 rounds in Garter stitch (creating 2 ridges)

Switch to stockinette stitch (knit all rounds) and continue until hat measures 9 cm - about 3,54 inches - from cast on edge.

Now, Switch to stockinette stitch with **black yarn** until hat measures 12 cm – about 4,72 inches from cas on edge.

## Decrease top of hat as follows:

Round 1: \*k2tog, k6\*, repeat until stitch remains, knit 1.

Row 2-4 : knit.

Row 5: \*k2tog, k5\* repeat until stitch remains, knit 1.

Round 6 and even rounds: knit.

Row 7: \*k2tog, k4\* repeat until stitch remains, knit 1.

Row 9: \*k2tog, k3\* repeat until stitch remains, knit 1.

Row 11: \*k2tog, k2\* repeat until stitch remains, knit 1.

Row 13: k2tog all stitches.

Break yarn and draw tail through the remaining stitches.
