Beanie Ladder

<u>Available in 2 sizes:</u> S : 54/56 cm of hat size. M : 57/59 cm of hat size. <u>Material :</u> 2 balls of Super Tweed Fonty : 1 of each color. Circular needles 4,5mm with a cable of 60 or 80, 1 stitch marker , cable needle, yarn needle.

Points and abbreviations :

- A : color of the yarn that will create the pattern on the top of the beanie.
- B : color of the yarn which gives the background color of the beanie.
- kA : knit in color A.
- kB : knit in color B.
- pB : purl in color B.
- slA : slip the stitch in color A
- K2togA : knit 2 stitches together in color A.
- *...* : repeat pattern between * and * as many times as needed to go to end of round. m1 : make 1

T1: cable 1 knitted in color A over 4 stitches: put 3 stitches (color B) on the cable needle placed behind the work, knit the next stitch in color A, take the 3 stitches on hold and knit them with color A.

T2 : cable 2 knitted in color A on 4 stitches: put 1 stitch (color A) on the cable needle placed in front of the work, knit the next 3 stitches in color A, take the stitch back on hold and knit it in color A.

T3 : cable 3 knitted over 2 stitches in color A. Put the first stitch on the cable needle placed in front of the work, knit the next, take the stitch from the holder and knit it.

Two-tone 1/1 rib knitted in the round:

Round to repeat for the collar: *kA1, pB1*

<u>Two-tone fancy stitch knitted in the round :</u>

Rounds 1 and 2 : *kA*.

Fancy stitch

Rounds 3, 4, 5 and 6 : *kB3, slA1* Round 7 : *T1* Round 8 : *kA*. Rounds 9 and 10 : * sIA1, kB1* Rounds 11 and 12 : *kA*. Rounds 13, 14, 15 and 16: *slA1, kB3* Round 17 : *T2* Round 18 : *kA*. Rounds 19 and 20 : * sIA1, kB1*

<u>Gauge Two-tone fancy stitch knitted in the round</u>: 21 stitches/32 rounds.

<u>Size S</u>: cast on 80 stitches in color A, put the stitch marker to indicate the beginning of the round, form the circle and knit 6 rounds in 1/1 rib. Then for size S make an increase round : *kA4, m1A*, then make a round in color A by knitting all stitches, then take the sequence of rounds common to knit in color A both sizes.

Size M : Cast on 88 stitches in color A, put on the stitch marker to indicate the beginning of the round, form the circle and knit 8 rounds in 1/1 rib. Then for size M, increase in round : *kA7, m1A* and finish the round by knitting the remaining 4 stitches in color A. Then make a round by knitting all the stitches in color A, then take the sequence of rounds common to both sizes.

For both sizes knit as follows:

- make a first pattern (Two-tone fancy stitch knitted in the round) knitted from round 3 until round 20 inclusive.

- make a second fancy pattern (two-tone fancy stitch knitted in the round) knitted entirely on rounds 1 to 20 inclusive

Go to decreases:

Round 1 : *kA8, K2togA.* Rounds 2 and 3: *slA1, kB1.*

Round 4 : *T3*

Round 5: *kA7, K2togA*

Rounds 7 and 8 : *slA1,kB1 .*

Round 9 : *T3*

Round 10 : *kA6, K2togA*

Rounds 11 and 12 : *slA1,kB1.*

V Slip stitch in color A



Round 13 : *T3* Round 14 : *kA5,K2togA* Rounds 15 and 16 : *slA1,kB1.* Round 17 : *T3* Round 18 : *kA4, K2togA* Rounds 19 and 20 : *slA1,kB1.* Round 21 : *T3* Round 22 : *kA3, K2togA* Rounds 23 and 24 : *slA1,kB1.* Round 25 : *T3* Round 26 : *kA2, K2togA*.

Cut the threads to about 25 cm in length, pass them through all the stitches at the top of the hat, remove the needles, tighten, repeat the operation, bring in the threads, and cut them short. Bring in and cut the other threads. You can make the finish you want: pompom, tassel etc.

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
